

# Apple macOS

## Certificates

Current Apple macOS versions have already integrated the required CA-certificates into the operating system. If you use an older version, the easiest way to get the required certificates is to download them from an existing network entrance.

- CA-certificate of the German Telekom:  
Deutsche Telekom Root CA 2
- CA-certificate of T-TeleSec:  
T-TeleSec GlobalRoot Class 2
- It is possible that the two chain certificates of the DFN-Verein are needed, too:
  - DFN-Verein Certification Authority 2
  - DFN-Verein Global G2

If the two certificates have already been installed, you will receive feedback from the system.

Now, execute the Wi-Fi configuration as described below.
