

WLAN / Wi-Fi

The computing centre of the Jade University offers all university members the use of wireless LAN (WLAN / Wi-Fi) via the eduroam procedure. eduroam is a worldwide infrastructure for WLAN / Wi-Fi access. With the uniformly used SSID "eduroam", a member of a participating organization can use WLAN / Wi-Fi access with all other eduroam participants.

When establishing a connection, each user logs in to their home institution, even if they are logging in to another eduroam participant. The WLAN / Wi-Fi configuration must be set up securely by the user so that the login only takes place with the login server of the home institution.
